In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **THURSDAY**, **NOVEMBER 15, 2018**, upon the application of **RICHLAND FARMS**, **INC.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Tuscaloosa Marine Shale Zone**, **Reservoir A**, in the Richland Plantation Field, East Feliciana Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To establish a single drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale Zone, Reservoir A.
- 2. To unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 3. To provide that any wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale Zone, Reservoir A, within or outside of the proposed unit, should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901, et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E), provided that there shall be no minimum spacing between unit wells inside the proposed unit.
- 4. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale Zone, Reservoir A, by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Tuscaloosa Marine Shale Zone, Reservoir A was previously defined by Office of Conservation Order No. 1395-A as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,620' and 13,043' (electrical log measurements) in the Oxy USA, Inc.-Richland Plantation A No. 1 Well (SN 215970), located in Section 69, Township 1 South, Range 2 East.

A plat is available for inspection in the Office of Conservation in Baton Rouge and Lafayette, Louisiana.
