- 3. To permit the unit operator, Maximus Operating, LTD to produce the unit allowable for the Travis Peak Zone from the unit well, the alternate unit well, or both wells, at its discretion.
- 4. Except to the extent contrary herewith, to continue in full force and effect the provisions of Order No. 270-152, effective August 8, 2017, and all applicable Statewide Orders.
- 5. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Travis Peak Zone was previously defined in Order No. 270-152, effective August 8, 2017.
