Application is hereby made on behalf of Maximus Operating, Ltd. ("Applicant") for a public hearing to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters relating to the Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 100, Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana:

Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 100

1. To establish rules and regulations governing the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 100, Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.
2. To create a drilling and production unit for the exploration and production of gas and condensate from the Travis Peak Zone such proposed unit being shown on the attached plat and being designated TP SU 100.
3. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis.
4. To propose that all wells drilled in the future to Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 100 inside and outside of the proposed unit herein be located in accordance with the provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
5. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner.
6. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

Pertinent data concerning this application is available for inspection at the office of Bryan S. Groves, 110 Oil Center Drive, The Live Oak Building, Lafayette, Louisiana 70503. A copy of any such data which is not otherwise available at the Office of Conservation can be obtained from Applicant at the expense of the requesting party.


In compliance with the Revised Rules of Procedure, a pre-application conference was provided, but no request for a conference was received and therefore, none was held.

A copy of the unit plats are enclosed herewith and a copy of this letter and of the attached plats are being sent to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation and to the Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties as shown on said list.

Applicant will provide for posting of a copy of the Legal Notice of this hearing and the enclosed plat at a prominent place in the area affected and will cause publication of the Legal Notice in a newspaper published in the general area of the Subject Field, all in accordance with the Revised Rules of Procedure. Furthermore, a copy of the Legal Notice will be mailed to all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties promptly upon receipt of the Legal Notice from the Commissioner.

Finally, there is enclosed herewith our check on behalf of the Applicant in the amount of \$755.00, made payable to the Office of Conservation representing the required hearing application fee.

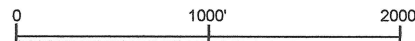
