## SUPPLEMENT TO OFFICE OF CONSERVATION ORDER NO. 70-D

FRIO Zone, Reservoir A, Richie Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

Supplemental Order concerning termination of the unit(s) created for the

Pursuant to authority contained in Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Section 9.1 after consideration of information presented on behalf of **Riceland Petroleum Company**, in compliance with the provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-L-3, the Commissioner of Conservation finds as follows:

- 1. The unit(s) for the Pool known as the FRIO Zone, Reservoir A, Richie Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, was created by Office of Conservation Order No. 70-D, effective July 20, 2010.
  - 2. That a period of one year and ninety days has elapsed without:
    - (a) Production from said Pool; and
    - (b) the existence of a well proven capable of producing from said Pool; and
    - (c) drilling, reworking, recompletion, deepening or plugging back operations having been conducted on a well to secure or restore production from said Pool.
- 3. That since sufficient time has elapsed without the occurrence of any of the conditions set forth in Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, Title 30, Section 9.1, with respect to said Pool and application for termination of said Unit(s) has been made and published according to law without the receipt of written objection thereto within the time provided, such application should be approved.

## <u>ORDER</u>

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. All Units established by Office of Conservation Order No. 70-D, effective July 20, 2010, for the Pool known as the FRIO Zone, Reservoir A, Richie Field, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, be and are hereby terminated and shall have no further force and effect.

This Supplemental Order shall be effective on and after February 14, 2018.
