In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1st Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3rd Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on TUESDAY, AUGUST 8, 2017, upon the application of PETROLEX OPERATING VENTURES, LLC.

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the Tuscaloosa Zone, in the Green Lake Field, West Baton Rouge Parish, Louisiana.

- 1. To establish a single ultra deep structure unit for the exploration for and production of gas and condensate from the Tuscaloosa Zone, Ultra Deep Structure.
- 2. To unitize all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 3. To approve and adopt a plan of development for the proposed ultra deep structure unit in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.1(B) of Title 30 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes.
- 4. To designate Petrolex Operating Ventures, LLC as operator of the proposed ultra deep structure unit.
- 5. To provide that any wells drilled to the Tuscaloosa Zone, Ultra Deep Structure, within or outside of the proposed unit should be located in accordance with the spacing provisions of LAC 43:XIX.1901 et seq. (Statewide Order No. 29-E) provided that there shall be no minimum spacing between unit wells inside the proposed unit.
- 6. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation should be authorized to reclassify the ultra deep structure unit by Supplemental Order without the necessity of a public hearing if the producing characteristics of the reservoir change and evidence to justify such reclassification is submitted to and accepted by the Commissioner of Conservation.
- 7. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Tuscaloosa Zone, Ultra Deep Structure is defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that gas and condensate bearing interval encountered between the electric log depths of 20,733' and 23,501' measured depth and 20,711' and 23,465' vertical depths, in the BP America Production Company-W.C. Parlange No. 11 Well, SN 223325, located in Section 49, Township 5 South, Range 9 East, Judge Digby Field, Pointe Coupee Parish, Louisiana.
