

**LEGAL NOTICE**

**STATE OF LOUISIANA, OFFICE OF CONSERVATION, BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

In accordance with the laws of the State of Louisiana, and with particular reference to the provisions of Title 30 of Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, a public hearing will be held in the Hearing Room, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, LaSalle Building, 617 North 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, at 9:00 a.m. on **TUESDAY, AUGUST 8, 2017**, upon the application of **MAXIMUS OPERATING, LTD.**

At such hearing the Commissioner of Conservation will consider evidence relative to the issuance of Orders pertaining to the following matters relating to the **Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 99**, in the Greenwood-Waskom Field, Caddo Parish, Louisiana.

1. To terminate, pursuant to Statewide Order No. 29-L-3, the 40 acre drilling and production units (4 units) located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 17 North, Range 16 West for the Harkrider Sand which were created by Office of Conservation Order No. 270-D, effective August 1, 1956.
2. Regarding the 40 acre drilling and production units (4 units) located in the Southwest Quarter of Section 13, Township 17 North, Range 16 West for the Harkrider Sand created by Order No. 270-D, effective August 1, 1956: (a) a period of five (5) years has elapsed without any production from the units (b) there are no wells located in the units which are capable of producing from the Pool for which the unit was established (c) a period of one year and ninety days has elapsed without any drilling, reworking, recompletion, deepening or plugging back operations having been conducted on a well(s) located in the units in an attempt to secure or restore production from the pools for which the units were established and (d) there are no unexpired drilling permits for the drilling of new wells in the units terminated to a depth which would penetrate the pools for which the units were established.
3. To confirm and continue in full force and effect the 640 acre unit adopted for the Travis Peak Zone located in Section 13, Township 17 North, Range 16 West, adopted by Order No. 270-1, effective August 1, 1964 and hereby designated as TP SU99.
4. To further define the Travis Peak Zone in the Waskom Field (later merged into Greenwood-Waskom Field), previously defined in Order No. 125-A, effective June 19, 1947.
5. Except as may be in conflict with the provisions hereof, the provisions of Order No. 270-1 shall remain in full force and effect.
6. To propose that all wells drilled in the future to Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 99 inside and outside of the unit being confirmed herein be located in accordance with the provisions of Statewide Order No. 29-E.
7. To provide that the Commissioner of Conservation may reclassify the reservoir by supplemental order without the necessity of a public hearing should such reclassification be warranted based on evidence furnished to the Commissioner of Conservation.
8. The Travis Peak Zone, Sand Unit 99 will be further defined as that gas and condensate bearing interval between the depths (electric log measurements) of 6,017' and 6,297' in the BHP Billiton (formerly PetroHawk Operating Company)-S.L. Herold No. 1 Well (SN 239089), located in Section 13, Township 17 North, Range 16 West.
9. To consider such other matters as may be pertinent.

The Travis Peak Zone was originally defined in Order No. 125-A as that gas bearing zone between the depths of 5,888' and 6,100' (electric log measurements) in the Arkansas Louisiana Gas Company, W. M. Bell No. 1 Well (SN 23110), located in Section 6, Township 17 North, Range 16 West in Waskom Field (later merged into Greenwood-Waskom Field).
